### **Intrinergy Hosts a Plant Tour for Mississippi Lawmakers**

**RICHMOND, VA, USA – October 8, 2008** – Intrinergy, a U.S.-based renewable energy company, welcomed a group of Mississippi lawmakers to its Wiggins, Mississippi biomass energy facility. The plant, built in 2007, supplies thermal energy from renewable biomass fuels to a local paper mill. The biomass energy plant reduces the mill's greenhouse gas emissions by approximately 20,000 tons per year of CO<sub>2</sub>e and significantly reduces its exposure to natural gas price volatility.
