Mark Warner served as governor of Virginia from 2002 until January 2006, and is now a Democratic candidate for the U.S. Senate. During his tenure as governor, Warner made strides on environmental issues including a record investment in the cleanup of the Chesapeake Bay. Developing a new energy policy that invests in renewables and eliminates U.S. dependence on foreign oil is a major focus of Warner's Senate campaign.
